

Orchestra Concert Attire

In the high school orchestra, there are two attire options for performances.

Option 1: Black Dress Shirt, Black Dress Pants, Black Dress Shoes, Silver Tie/Bowtie
Dress shirt and tie are to be purchased from Miller's Attire in NP.
The cost will be \$30 for a shirt and tie. Bow Ties may be slightly extra.

Option 2: Black Floor-Length Dress, Black Dress Shoes
All students will wear the same dress from Southeastern Apparel.
The cost will be \$56 for the dress.

Checks can be made to "DOVER ORCHESTRA BOOSTERS". The Booster group will be ordering all dresses in one order to gain access to lower bulk costs.

If you already own a dress from band or choir, you do not need to purchase a new one.
If you are financially unable to afford this expense right now, this DOES NOT mean you will not receive the proper attire.

Attire to Avoid
